

RESOLUTION 7-2024
Port of Skamania County Board of Commissioners
Accepting Revisions to the Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements

Recitals

WHEREAS, the Port of Skamania County (Port) is a municipal corporation of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, as provided in RCW 53.20.010, the Port has adopted a Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements (Comprehensive Scheme), dated January 4, 1966, as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Port's Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interests of the Port to revise said Comprehensive Scheme; and

WHEREAS, public workshop was held on August 20, 2024 to discuss with the Port Commission and the general public the proposed revisions to the Comprehensive Scheme; and

WHEREAS, on August 20, 2020 a public hearing on the Comprehensive Scheme revision was held in accordance with RCW 53.25, and the notice provision of RCW 53.20.020 has been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Port Commission finds the full and complete Port of Skamania County Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements should be revised as provided below.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Skamania County:

1. Adopts the document attached as Exhibit A hereto and incorporated by reference as the Comprehensive Scheme of Harbor Improvements of the Port of Skamania County until such time as the same is modified pursuant to law.

2. To the extent prior resolutions creating or amending the Comprehensive Scheme are inconsistent with the Comprehensive Scheme attached as Exhibit A, those resolutions of the Port Commission are superseded. To the extent that resolutions are consistent, they shall remain in full force and effect.

3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the Port Commission at the meeting whose date appears below.
